What is a Covenant? – A Covenant is an agreement that brings about a relationship of commitment. In the Bible we see God making covenants with his people in order to bring them to a life of commitment to him. For the purposes of our group, this covenant will act as an agreement between everyone involved to bring about a relationship of commitment and accountability.

- ▶ I will be respectful of my fellow group members' time by showing up on time and making group meetings a priority.
- ▶ I will give my group members notice and reason if a situation arises that would cause me to miss a group meeting.
- ▶ I will maintain an appropriate level of confidentiality with the things my fellow group members share with me.
- ▶ I will be honest with my fellow group member's about my actions and intentions.

Everyone desiring to be involved in a Life Group must first agree to abide by ALL parts of this covenant. Understanding and accepting these simple guidelines will help to make every group a success.
